## Pro Life Report — *Del Ridder*

At this time Planned Parenthood with its vast financial chest is involved in several lawsuits/hearings across the USA. Can't detail here all the lawsuits but consider just the following documented practice of PP .

... "Section 211 of the Department of Health and Human Services Appropriations Act 2002 declares that no provider of services under Title X shall be exempt from any state law requiring notification or the reporting of child abuse, child molestation or sexual abuse. (PP) received \$59 million Title X grants (our tax dollars) during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002.

A nationwide cover-up by Planned Parenthood was exposed by Life Dynamics Inc., Denton, Texas in 2002.

"... LDI hired a 23 year old woman with a young sounding voice to pose as a 13 year-old who thought she was pregnant by her 22 year-old boyfriend. She called nearly 1,000 family-planning centers across the county including most Planned Parenthood facilities." Most cases were taped by LDI. "In about 80 percent of the calls to PP centers the clinic worker agreed to conceal or knowingly ignore the suspected felony sexual abuse (in this case, statutory rape.), often even acknowledging the criminal nature of the relationship."<sup>1</sup>

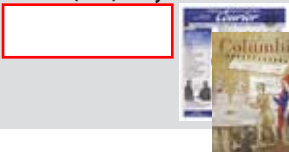
