Grand Knight's Report continued

Beer Bread Bierock Recipe

(*a.k.a. Runza*)

6 cups flour

2 packages dry yeast

1 tablespoon salt

3 tablespoons sugar

3 tablespoons margarine,
softened

1 whole egg

2 cups beer, warm

1\4 cup warm water (for yeast)

1 head cabbage, chopped

2 lbs. ground beef

1 large white onion, chopped

1 cup beer

1 teaspoon garlic powder

3 tablespoons Worcestershire
sauce

Salt and pepper to taste

1. Combine the first set of dry ingredients in a large bowl (exclude 3 cups of flour and the yeast).
2. Dissolve yeast in warm water and combine with beer, margarine and egg in small bowl.
3. Then combine the wet and dry ingredients in a mixer and slowly add the remaining 3 cups of flour.
4. You will have to knead the dough to work in the last of the flour, set aside and let it rise until double.
5. Brown ground beef and drain, add chopped onion and chopped cabbage a half head at a time.
6. Cook the cabbage down while adding salt, pepper, garlic powder, beer, and Worcestershire sauce.
7. Cook for approx. 20 minutes over medium heat stirring constantly. Remove from heat.

8. Pull a lime size chunk of the raised dough and knead on a floured board, roll out to 6 inch diameter, place 2 to 3 tablespoons of meat and cabbage mixture on the dough, pull up and seal the edges.
9. Place seam side down on a greased cooking sheet and bake at 400 degrees for 12 - 15 minutes or until golden brown.

A labor of love from the heart, and from what I see in you all, your mothers' Heart is in you too. Continue with the effort, it will be worth it. Mothers' day is coming up, tell your mother and/or the mother of your children that they are appreciated and loved, and thank them for all their effort, and their Heart.
